**ARUSHA-TARANGIRE&LAKE MANYARA NATIONAL PARK-NGORONGORO CRATER-
SERENGETI-KIGOMANI**
14 Days/ 13 Nights

THE GREAT MIGRATION SAFARI

DAY 1 ARUSHA

Arusha is the safari capital of Tanzania located at the foot of Mt. Meru, close to Mount Kilimanjaro, the Manyara, Tarangire and Ngorongoro National Parks. From there it is only a short trip to the Serengeti. Just to the north, on the slopes of Mt. Meru is the Arusha National Park. Built by the Germans as a center of colonial administration because of the temperate climate, Arusha is a good spot to take a day or two off from your safari.

Arrival to Kilimanjaro Airport and meet our representatives, transfer from airport to the hotel of your choice.

DAY 2 TANGARIRE NATIONAL PARK

Breakfast

After the Serengeti, Tarangire has the greatest concentration of wildlife in Tanzania and in the dry season the Tarangire River is a magnet for thirsty wildlife. Large herds of elephants and migratory wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, impala, gazelle, hartebeest, and eland gather and not surprisingly the predators follow. This is also the one place in Tanzania where dry-country antelope such as oryx and gerenuk are regularly spotted. Tarangire is also known for its spectacular baobab trees, and its breathtaking views of the Masaii Steppe and the mountains to the south. Located just a few hours' drive from the town of Arusha, Tarangire is a popular stop for safaris travelling through the northern circuit on their way to Ngorongoro and the Serengeti. The park extends into two game-controlled areas and the wildlife can move freely throughout.

Leave early in the morning to Tarangire National Park for a full day game drive in this huge park which is particularly interesting in the dry season from June to October since Tarangire River provides the last water supply in the area which attracts an enormous amount of wild life including large herds of elephants, buffaloes, zebra's, wildebeests, big predators like lions, leopards and cheetah's. Picnic lunch at the designated site overlooking the Tarangire River or Silale Swamp.

DAY 4 LAKE MANYARA NATIONAL PARK

Breakfast

With the Lake on its East and the Manyara Escarpment to its West, Lake Manyara National Park offers breathtaking views and a large variety of habitats. Acacia woodlands, lush junglelike groundwater forests, baobab strewn cliffs, algae-streaked hot springs, swamps, and the alkaline lake itself. And thanks to this, the small Park can support many animal species and an incredible bird life. Manyara has the largest concentration of baboons anywhere in the world and the lions here are also renowned for their tree climbing.

Leave in the morning for a full day game drive in Lake Manyara National Park, visit the lake, see herds of elephants, big families of baboons and Hippo's in their pool. Because of the varied environment you will also see a lot of different species of birds and antelopes, giraffe, zebra's, and wildebeests. Pic nick lunch at one of the designated sites.

DAY 5 NGORONGORO CRATER

Breakfast

The Ngorongoro Crater is game viewing gone crazy and it is not surprising that with is one of Tanzania's major tourist drawcards. Within the crater rim a daily wildlife drama is played out as large herds of zebra and wildebeest graze nearby lions, leopards, elephants, and black rhinos. Outside of the crater a similar drama continues in a more spread out manner with Masai herdsmen thrown into the mix.

Early in the morning drive to Ngorongoro Crater for a game drive, pass Lake Magadi with its flamingo's, see the hippo's in their pool and see how buffalo's, elephants, wildebeests, zebra's, different types of gazelles, lions and cheetah's share the same environment. In the afternoon you start your ascent out of the Crater and drive to your Lodge near the Rim of Ngorongoro Crater for a wonderful dinner and overnight

DAY 6 CENTRAL SERENGETI

Breakfast

The Serengeti together with Kenya's Masai Mara Game Park form Africa's most famous wildlife park. The image of acacia trees on an endless grass plain epitomizes Africa for many, and then add a Masai warrior and some cattle to the picture and the conversation need go no further. The annual wildebeest migration through the Serengeti and the Masai Mara is the largest mass movement of land mammals on the planet – with more than a million animals following the rains. But that is not where the game viewing ends, large prides of lions, elephants and giraffes in grasslands, gazelles, and eland to mention but a few. Aside from traditional vehicle safaris, hot-air ballooning over the Serengeti plains has become almost essential and you can even do a horseback safari.

In the morning you will start your journey to Serengeti National Park, passing through the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Conservation area means that the area is a protected environment for the wildlife but there are also villages where the original Maasai live. Start your game drive after Naabi Gate where you have lunch and enjoy the wildlife driving towards your camp. If you are interested in archaeology you can also visit Oldupai Gorge, this place is famous for the earliest findings of a 1.8 million year old skull and 3,7 million year old footprints of a Hominid (human like). Here you can also have lunch while getting informed by professionals.
